Current level three restrictions will affect Church Services as detailed below:

1. All Church services will cease at level three.
2. A maximum of twenty-five people may attend funeral services.
3. A maximum of twenty-five people may attend wedding services.
4. Travel, other than essential services and work, is confined to one's own county.
5. Baptisms will be postponed at level three as gatherings other than weddings or funerals are not permitted in church or indoors.

The Parish Office will remain open from Tuesday - Friday 10am to 5pm (closed 1-2pm for lunch) and Fr John will continue to say private Masses for any intentions that have already been booked.
