**Adoration will recommence in Duleek Church on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> November from 2-6pm for individual private prayer.**

Level 5 restrictions will affect Church Services as detailed below:

1. Churches will remain open for private prayer.
2. Public Masses will cease.
3. A maximum of twenty-five people may attend funeral services.
4. A maximum of twenty-five people may attend wedding services.
5. Travel, other than essential services and work, is confined to 5k from your home.
6. Baptisms will be postponed at level 5 as gatherings other than weddings or funerals are not permitted in church or indoors.

The Parish Office will remain open from Tuesday - Friday 10am to 5pm (closed 1-2pm for lunch) and private Masses will be offered for any intentions that have already been booked.

**Bus Service for Duleek** - The National Transport Authority are asking you to help to provide feedback on how accessible you find the public transport system in your own area. We have no local bus serving Drogheda - Bellewstown - Duleek - Donore - Drogheda and no bus Drogheda - Duleek - Navan (which we had some years ago but was taken off) for work, hospital appointments, shopping etc. Only 2 buses to Dublin at 06.40am and 07.15am and from Dublin at 17.24pm and 18.34pm which is not a good service as the population is growing. We have an opportunity to make our views known by signing the petition in Duleek Post Office or filling in the "Survey on Accessibility of Public Transport " or write to Transport Accessibility Manager, Dun Sceine, Iveagh Court, Harcourt Lane, Dublin 2 DO2 WT20. **Closing date is 3rd December and is fully supported by Duleek Women's Forum.**
