Christmas Envelopes: Many thanks to all who have already contributed – Envelopes may still be placed in appropriate boxes in the church or in the parish office.

Level 5 restrictions will affect Church Services as detailed below:

1. Churches will remain open for private prayer.
2. Public Masses will cease.
3. A maximum of twenty-five people may attend funeral services.
4. A maximum of twenty-five people may attend wedding services, this will reduce to 6 people from January 2nd 2021.
5. Baptisms will be postponed at level 5 as gatherings other than weddings or funerals are not permitted in church or indoors.

The Parish Office will remain open from Tuesday - Friday 10am to 5pm (closed 1-2pm for lunch) and private Masses will be offered for any intentions that have already been booked.

The Parish Website will be updated weekly and will feature the Parish Bulletin, Mass Readings and online notices. Online Mass will now be available every Sunday @ 11am during lockdown. You can access the website at
