Level 5 restrictions will affect Church Services as detailed below:

1. Churches will remain open for private prayer.
2. Public Masses will cease.
3. A maximum of ten people may attend funeral services.
4. A maximum of 6 people may attend wedding services.
5. Travel, other than essential services and work, is confined to 5k from your home.
6. Baptisms will be postponed at level 5 as gatherings other than weddings or funerals are not permitted in church or indoors.
