Duleek Cystic Fibrosis 10K

The 9th annual Duleek Virtual 10K takes place on Sunday 25th April. From now until 25th April you can take part at any time and raise much needed funds for Cystic Fibrosis Ireland. Duleek Community Shop - Due to present restrictions the shop is closed. At the moment we cannot except donations and ask people **NOT** to leave black bags outside the shop as happened several times in the last few weeks.

Level 5 restrictions will affect Church Services as detailed below:

- 1. Churches will remain open for private prayer.
- 2. Public Masses will cease.
- 3. A maximum of ten people may attend funeral services.
- 4. A maximum of 6 people may attend wedding services.
- 5. Travel, other than essential services and work, is confined to 5k from your home.

The Parish Office is now open Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday 10am - 5pm (closed 1-2pm for lunch)

Private Masses will be offered for any intentions that have already been booked.

The Green Kilometre Scheme

In response to requests from numerous community groups and individuals throughout the county, Meath County Council has created the Green Kilometre Scheme. The scheme invites individuals and groups to choose approximately a kilometre stretch of road in their area and commit to maintaining the chosen stretch over the course of the year. Meath County Council will support any group or individual who would like to get involved by supplying native trees, litter pickers, bags and gloves. Once restrictions allow, the Council can arrange for an advisor to visit and give advice in relation to planting and taking care of heritage features.
