Duleek Library re-opens - In line with the easing of Covid 19 restrictions Duleek Library has re-opened since the 10th of May as part of the Governments 'The Path Ahead' plan.

Established in 1917 Knockcommon combines small class sizes and individual attention which go hand in hand with a wealth of extra-curricular opportunities. We cater for boys and girls from Junior Infants to 6th class. We offer a wide range of extra-curricular activities in the belief that these assist in education of the whole person.

Further to the government announcement on 29th April the following restrictions will apply from Monday 10th May in respect of Religious Services:

- Public Masses will recommence.
- As before Duleek Church will be divided into 2 pods, the upper section will accommodate 50 people socially distanced and the lower section will accommodate 50 people socially distanced.
- People entering the Church at the main entrance will be directed to the lower section of the Church.
- People entering the Church at either of the side entrances will be directed to the upper section of the Church.
- Stewards will be on site to assist in this regard.
- 2m social distancing guidelines adhered to (members of the same household can sit/stand close together).
- Face masks are mandatory (except for those people exempt as outlined under HSE guidelines).
- The maximum attendance at funerals and weddings will increase to 50.
- Sunday and Holy Day obligations can be fulfilled by attending Mass anytime during the week.
- Baptisms can be booked by contacting the Parish Office.
- **Please note to limit the number of people attending any given Mass we can only include 2 intentions per Mass.**

Duleek Cardiac First Response Group are now back live with the National Ambulance Service. We will be tasked to cardiac arrest, ineffective breathing and choking calls. Responders will be wearing full PPE whilst attending calls. All our responders are volunteers who give up their time to go on roster so it may not be possible to have someone on call all the time but we will certainly try our best. We are alerted to an incident by text message from National Emergency Operations Centre once someone has made a 999/112 call. Thank you to all our responders for all their hard work.
