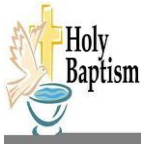

Restrictions in respect of Religious Services:

- Public Masses will recommence.
- As before Duleek Church will be divided into 2 pods, the upper section will accommodate 50 people socially distanced and the lower section will accommodate 50 people socially distanced.
- People entering the Church at the main entrance will be directed to the lower section of the Church.
- People entering the Church at either of the side entrances will be directed to the upper section of the Church.
- Stewards will be on site to assist in this regard.
- 2m social distancing guidelines adhered to (members of the same household can sit/stand close together).
- Face masks are mandatory (except for those people exempt as outlined under HSE guidelines).
- Up to 50 people can attend a wedding service with up to 25 attending a wedding reception (indoor or outdoor)
- Funerals can have up to 50 mourners. Gatherings before or after the funeral should not take place.
- Sunday and Holy Day obligations can be fulfilled by attending Mass anytime during the week.
- Baptisms can be booked by contacting the Parish Office 041-9823205
- **Please note to limit the number of people attending any given Mass we can only include 2 intentions per Mass.**
