RITE OF INSTALLATION OF A NEW PARISH PRIEST. This Ceremony of Induction or Installation is an occasion when a new Parish Priest is formally presented to the parish in a liturgical context. The ceremony is so arranged to remind the faith community and the pastor of their responsibility together before God to serve Christ in his Church, and by their holiness and the example of their lives, individually and as a local community, to promote the mission of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Following the appointment of the Parish Priest by the Bishop, it is fitting that he be suitably introduced to the people of the parish and in turn to be welcomed by them. Bishop Tom will join with us to celebrate this Rite at 12noon Mass next Sunday 15th August, *The Feast of the Assumption of Our Lady*. We seek the intercession of Our Lady for Fr. Mark and us all in the Parishes of Duleek and Donore as we strive together in our time and place to continue that great *Fiat/Yes* to God which Our Lady accepted and at the end of her days on earth was rewarded with the cloud of God receiving her immaculate body into His eternal embrace of Heavenly glory. The teams of sacristans in the four churches will represent the people of both parishes at this Mass. As usual we are still restricted to the two pods of around fifty for our Masses but we hope that in these weeks ahead once people feel comfortable with enough space in the seats/pews we might fit a few more in! - After the period of personal prayer and thanksgiving, the priest will invite all to stand for the Concluding Prayer and Blessing.

We express our thanks to the Sacristans, those who help with the sanitising, the Ministers of the Word & Holy Communion, those involved with music, the welcoming stewards and collectors, for their generous assistance at our celebrations of Mass at the weekend and during the week. It is hugely appreciated as we gather with respect and safely to worship God and celebrate the precious gift of Holy Mass.
