#### **OUR CHURCHES**

Emerging from all the restrictions associated with limiting the spread of Covid we do so slowly and with continued care for all who gather in our churches. We are most grateful for all who have so diligently prepared and sanitised our churches for the resumption of public worship, and indeed kept the churches Covid compliant during the long periods of lockdown, so as to enable parishioners visit for private prayer-time amid the ongoing anxiety and concern everyone faced. We also express our thanks to those who so generously assisted with the welcoming and ushering in our churches when it was possible again to gather for the celebration of Mass.

Now it is permissible to have fifty percent capacity for Mass but we anticipate the full lifting of restrictions towards the end of October. So in the meantime we hope everyone feels welcome and safe to attend and participate in the Mass. If younger people in a family see an older parishioner or couple come in need of a seat, perhaps they might kindly give up their place and stand along the side or at the back or use the gallery where possible. Please continue to wear face masks and ensure social distance from those not in your household. Please also use the hand sanitisers provided on entry to the church and as you leave.

It may be tempting to immediately invite extra family and friends to a child's Baptism but we'd ask you to appreciate our need to continue the limited number permissible, for on such occasions there is a lot of mixing of families and households when we have two or more infants for Baptism. Also when a loved one dies the family may consider the ritual of having the Reception of the Body into the church the evening before the funeral. It can ease the pressure on numbers attending just one ceremony. Let us keep vigilant and constant in our prayers for an end to this pandemic experience and please God we will soon be back to a more relaxed and normal way of life and worship!
