**FEAST OF ST. BRIGID, 1<sup>ST</sup> FEBRUARY** To mark the Feast of St. Brigid, Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> February, it would be great if parishioners who have some free time could make a few extra crosses to bring to this Mass for blessing and distribution. It is an Irish tradition for such crosses to be placed in farm sheds to protect the animals from any harm and to seek God's blessing upon all involved in farming as we in Ireland mark the beginning of springtime!

## THE SYNODAL PATHWAY IN THE DIOCESE OF MEATH



All the baptised in the Diocese of Meath are invited to participate in the synodal process during Lent 2022. *The Synodal Process is first and foremost a spiritual process. It is not a mechanical data-gathering exercise or a series of meetings and debates.*

*Synodal listening is oriented towards discernment. ... ## CELEBRATION OF HOLY MASS

This is a guide taken from the Missal on our posture during the Mass as we participate in the Sacred Liturgy.

### THE INTRODUCTORY RITES

**Stand** for the *Entrance Procession* until after *The Collect (Opening Prayer)*

### THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

**Sit** until the *Gospel Acclamation*

**Stand** for the *Gospel Acclamation* and *The Gospel*

**Sit** for the *Homily* and a period of quiet reflection

**Stand** for *The Creed and Prayer of the Faithful*

### THE LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

**Sit** for *The Offertory* and preparation of the gifts.

**Stand** for *The Preface (The Lord be with you etc.)* until the conclusion of the *Sanctus (Holy, Holy, Holy)*

**Kneel** for *The Eucharistic Prayer*

### THE COMMUNION RITE

**Stand** for *The Lord's Prayer*

**Kneel** after *The Agnus Dei (Lamb of God)*

During the distribution of Holy Communion please wait until the Ministers are at the various stations and then reverently proceed to receive, being mindful of giving space to the person ahead of you.

### THE CONCLUDING RITES

**Stand** for *The Prayer After Communion, Blessing and Dismissal*
