



THE SYNODAL PATHWAY FOR THE PARISHES IN THE DULEEK DEANERY



Sincere thanks to the parishioners who participated in this synodal process at our Deanery level. Since Lent began, such gatherings were held every Tuesday evening in the eight deaneries of the diocese. Together, at the request of Pope Francis, we engaged in the discernment process guided by the Holy Spirit. We will conclude this stage of the Synodal Pathway on the weekend of Divine Mercy Sunday at Mass in every parish of our deanery. Please continue to pray for the Synod as the Catholic Church prepares for the next stage in the process which will culminate in the Synod scheduled for Rome in October 2023.
