THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION This week in our parishes of Donore and Duleek we have the privilege of welcoming Bishop Tom and celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation. Perhaps as a consequence of the pandemic, we have had time to appreciate even more the gift of the Sacraments in our lives. Such occasions are sacred events in the family and our whole faith community: Sacred encounters with God and the great communion of the saints, in which we the baptised are part off here on earth as we journey towards the promise of Heaven. We so easily take things for granted but now in light of what we have experienced in recent years, during the Covid pandemic, let us celebrate with renewed zeal the grace of the Holy

Spirit to inspire and direct our lives, to protect and bless our families, especially those celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation. As we pray for all the Confirmation candidates let us ponder the words of Pope Francis with regard the Sacrament of Confirmation. "When we welcome the Holy Spirit into our hearts and allow him to act, Christ makes himself present in us and takes shape in our lives; through us, it will be he – Christ himself – who prays, forgives, gives hope and consolation, serves the brethren, draws close the needy and to the least, creates community and sows peace. Think how important this is: by means of the Holy Spirit, Christ himself comes to do all this among us and for us. That is why it is important that children and young people receive the Sacrament of Confirmation".



As we begin our spiritual journey of Lent, our sacred time of 'operation transformation' set aside an extra bit of time for prayer, daily Mass, or Eucharistic Adoration. Maybe set up a sacred space/altar in your home with the Bible at the centre and use the Trocaire Box as a visible reminder of how fortunate we are and of what we can share with those whose needs are greater. And of course we are called to give up some favourite foods/sweets or even T.V., iPad or Facebook time

as a way of fasting for Lent! Remember that as Catholics we are asked to abstain from meat every Friday and if possible every Wednesday, so perhaps you might also consider keeping this practice for Lent! During Lent there will be Mass every Wednesday morning at 7.30am in St Cianán's Church, Duleek. Fr. Mark will also host a zoom meet every Thursday from 8:30-9pm for Lectio Divina; a shared reflection upon the Sunday Gospels of Lent.

THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (R.C.I.A.) is the preparatory course undertaken by adults who seek to become members of the Catholic Faith Community. It concludes with Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation being celebrated at the Easter Vigil. On the First Sunday of Lent in the Cathedrals the catechumens celebrate the rite of 'election' or 'enrolment'.
