Let us persevere in invoking the gift of peace for the whole world, especially for dear and tormented Ukraine. Happy Monday of the Angel! Please do not forget to pray for me."



DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY The message of Divine Mercy and the recitation of the 3 o'clock prayer has become a popular expression of trust in the Lord. In the great Jubilee Year 2000 Sr. Faustina was canonized as the first saint of the New Millennium and the Second Sunday after Easter dedicated as Divine Mercy Sunday. Let us continue to pray for Mercy and seek the pierced hands and side of the Risen Lord to protect and bless us and the whole world. As Pope St. John Paul II said in the canonization homily, "What will the years ahead bring us? What will our future on earth be like? We are not given to know. However, it is certain that in addition to new progress there will unfortunately be no lack of painful experiences. But

the light of divine mercy, which the Lord in a way wished to return to the world through Sr. Faustina's charisms will illumine the way for the men and women of the third millennium."
