CEMETERY SUNDAY WEEKEND JUNE 10th/11th 2023

Blessing of the graves will take place on Saturday 10th June at 5pm in Crossmacole Cemetery and in St. Mary's Abbey after the Vigil Mass. On Sunday 11th at 1pm in Holy Cross & Good Shepherd cemeteries.

In recent weeks discarded rubbish has been left piled up in Holy Cross cemetery, even under the No Dumping Sign! Such activity shows

disrespect to the memory and dignity of our deceased loved ones. Please take home materials being removed from family graves. Any company employed to carry out monumental works must tidy appropriately after completing their job and respect the surrounding graves. Everyone's efforts to keep the cemetery neat and a befitting sacred burial ground for the faithful departed is greatly appreciated.

ALTAR SERVERS Being an altar server is a brilliant job at Mass! Altar servers lend a hand getting everything ready in the church before Mass time. They help the priest and all the people to celebrate the Mass. Altar servers can also help at funerals and weddings too! Altar servers keep an eye to make sure the bells are rung at the right time, reminding everyone it's a special moment in the Mass. They look after the books, the chalice, the candles and many other things as well. Usually kids can begin altar serving once they have made their first Holy Communion. You can start at any age and keep serving even when at secondary school. So if you'd like to be an altar server watch this space over the next few weeks!



SEEKING A BLESSING It is custom to have a new house or car blessed; perhaps even the farm in Spring or the office or work place for God's protection etc. Please don't hesitate to request such a blessing from Fr. Mark or Fr. Anthony. Always feel free to phone or email the Parish Office to make arrangements. Also if permitted by the hospital or nursing residence Fr. Mark and Fr. Anthony would gladly visit any parishioner if they or their family so desired. Be assured too that most hospitals and nursing care facilities usually have pastoral care procedures provided for Anointing the sick and bringing Holy Communion, just ask and they will make arrangements for you and your loved ones.

AREA MASSES As we emerge from "the tomb of the covid pandemic" let us this Eastertide and in the summer months ahead celebrate the joy of friendship shared with families and neighbours. As we thank God for his protection and blessings these past few years consider gathering your local community together for an area Mass in a front garden or an estate green!
