NEW BISHOP OF ARDAGH & CLONMACNOISE Today one of our own priests in the Meath Diocese, Paul Connell, will be ordained and consecrated as the new Bishop of Ardagh & Clonmacnoise. The ceremony will be broadcast on the webcam at St Mel's Cathedral, Longford www.longfordparish.com Bishop Paul is a native of Mullingar and has served for most of his priestly ministry as a teacher and the President of St Finian's college. In 2019 he was appointed Diocesan Secretary and also to the Educational Secretariat of the Irish Bishop's Conference in Maynooth. Bishop Paul is the third Meath priest in 10 years to be chosen by the Pope to be a Bishop elsewhere in Ireland, Bishop Denis Nulty serving in Kildare & Leighlin Diocese since 2013 and Archbishop Dermot Farrell in Dublin since 2021. We hold Bishop Paul in our prayers and implore God's blessing upon him and the people of his new Diocese as he becomes the Shepherd in the Lord's name.

DAY FOR LIFE 2023 Day for Life is celebrated this year on Sunday 18 June. The theme is 'Listen to Her' and focuses on the experience of one Catholic woman in the aftermath of abortion. It tells of her journey towards healing. The hope is that this will help people to listen, to understand and to respond with compassion. Papal Message for the Day for Life 2023 "In listening to Mary, our Mother, and following her example, he invites us to discover our personal call from God who is the source of our existence, reminding us that, "Each human being is called by God to enjoy the fullness of life; and, is entrusted to the maternal care of the Church. Every threat to human dignity and life cannot but have an effect on her heart, on her maternal 'womb'. To defend life is not an ideology for the Church.
