MASS FOR THE SICK It was a special occasion for us all who gathered last Saturday to celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick and implore God's healing grace upon all who are carrying the burden of illness. Our most sincere gratitude to everyone who assisted, especially the Duleek Women's Group. Don't hesitate to contact the Parish Office if you wish to let Fr. Mark & Fr. Anthony know that you or a family member is sick in hospital or at home. All the sick in our parishes will be remembered in the prayers. When parishioners are not able to attend Mass due to old age or ill health the priests can call with Holy Communion on the First Fridays of every month. A Minister of Holy Communion may also bring Holy Communion to the house after the weekend Mass.



THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM "With joy the Christian Community welcomes you." These are words from the opening gestures of the Rite of Baptism. Yes, baptism involves the whole faith community and together we share the journey of following Christ in this world leading to Heaven, with the child, with the parents and the godparents. As the wider circle of family and community we pray and support one another in seeking the grace of God to enable us be what we are baptised for; evangelisers! Worshiping and celebrating the mercy and love of God at home and in church, so as to spread the Good News to all around us as we live

out the joys and sorrows, the highs and the lows that are part and parcel of being individuals and couples, family and neighbours, friends and strangers. Together let us continue to create an awareness of how close at hand the Kingdom of God is! The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is also available for those who seek to become a Catholic. To make arrangements for the Sacrament of Baptism please contact the Parish Office. The completed Sacrament of Baptism Booking Form is then returned at the weekend Mass, after which the priest will bless the family in preparation for the Baptism. Pre-Baptism Courses will take place on the last Thursday of every month and parents (godparents may also attend) attend one before the intended Baptism date. Please keep those being presented for baptism in your daily prayers. A Pregnancy Blessing can be requested at any time from the priests either after Mass or by contacting the Parish Office.



THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE "This was the first of the signs given by Jesus: it was given at Cana in Galilee. He let his glory be seen, and his disciples believed in him." The sacraments are signs of Jesus with us still! We think of that couple at Cana and how the Lord was so close to them. We invite couples to allow Jesus to be as close them and despite all that can happen in the years ahead, even running out of the wine of love, to trust in how Jesus can turn water into wine! Such is the dept of Christ's love as couples strive to

become unison in mind, body, heart and soul. To make arrangements for the Sacrament of Marriage please contact the Parish Office. The completed Sacrament of Marriage Booking Form is then returned at the weekend Mass, after which the priest will bless the couple as they begin the spiritual journey to their wedding day. At least six month's notice must be given before the intended date. The Sacrament of Marriage can be celebrated simply with the Liturgy of the Word or also with the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Please keep all engaged couples in prayer as they prepare for the Sacrament of Marriage and living it 'for better or worse, for richer or poorer, in sickness and health, all the days of their lives'.

DULEEK & DONORE PARISHES PILGRIMAGE 2023 Last year we climbed Croagh Patrick! This year we again follow St. Patrick as we make the Pilgrim Path along the lake shore overlooking the Station Island of Lough Derg, Co. Donegal. The Lough Derg Pilgrim Path in 2014 became part of Pilgrim Paths Ireland, a network of 12 traditional pilgrim routes scattered across the island of Ireland. It is a 12k route which follows a pilgrim way that was used in the Middle Ages by pilgrims to St Patrick's Purgatory. It might also be possible for our group to visit the Island while we are there.
