The Lough Derg Camino

Join with Fr. Mark & Fr. Anthony as we again follow in the way of St. Patrick! This year we make

the Pilgrim Path along the lake shore overlooking the Station Island of Lough Derg, St. Patrick's Purgatory, Co. Donegal. By chance a national event is happening when we are there to mark this being the Year of Prayer for Priestly Vocations (see www.loughderg.org lakeshore-pilgrimage for more info). The walk is reduced to 8k so as to enable everyone to be ferried over to St. Patrick's Purgatory. On the Station Island we will have a wonderful opportunity to see and understand this sacred place. While there we will join in the national praver service, followed by refreshments; so no fasting or bare feet!! If you or your family is interested we need to get the total numbers travelling soon due to costs of transport. To book your seat on the bus please contact Caroline at the Parish Office by Wednesday! Even if you may not be able to do much walking you are welcome to come along and join with us. Children up to 18 years of age will need to be accompanied by a parent, grandparent or guardian to comply with our Safe-guarding policy. You'll need good comfortable footwear with strong ankle support. Perhaps bring a good walking stick too. A wee bag to carry on your back may be useful as everyone will need to carry water, some sweets/bars etc and of course weather can be unpredictable so it is advisable to have raingear and also a warm top as it can change considerably when out on the boat and Island. The celebration of Mass will take place along the Pilgrim Path way. Refreshments will be provided on the Island and on the way home if still 'hungry' we will stop in Cavan for a bite to eat. Donation only for the bus and for St. Patrick's Purgatory/Station Island. Looking forward to another special pilgrimage together!

spoke these words, "Dear young friends, today we too need something of this burst of light, so that it can fill us with hope as we face the many failures of each day and the darkness that assails us in life, and respond to them with the light of the resurrection of Jesus. For he is the light that never sets, the **Blessed Sacrament** light that shines even in the dead of night. As the priest Ezra said, God has illumined our eyes. Our God illumines: he illumines our vision, our hearts, our minds, our desire to do something with our lives. The Lord's light always shines. Yet, I would like to tell you that we do not radiate light by putting ourselves in the spotlight, for that type of light is blinding. No, we cannot illumine others by projecting a perfect, wellordered, refined image of ourselves, or by appearing to be powerful and successful, strong but without light. No, we radiate light – we shine – by welcoming Jesus into our hearts and learning to love as he does. To love like Jesus: that is what makes us shine, makes us do works of love. Friends, I am telling you the truth: whenever you do works of love, you become light". Spending time in adoration before the Blessed Sacrament we are bathed in the great light and love of God. Pope Francis encouraged the young people to go and spend time in adoration. Giving time to Jesus who gives us everything in the name of the Father! Jesus gave his Body on the Cross for love of God and for all humanity. Come behold this wonderous presence exposed in the monstrance. Come on Tuesdays in adoration in Donore church after 9am Mass until 10am; on Tuesday evenings in Duleek church from 6-7pm; on Wednesdays from 8:30-9:30am in Bellewstown church and from September every Saturday evening in Duleek church there will be a directed Holy Hour of adoration and benediction from 5:30-6:30pm with the Sacrament of Reconciliation from 6:30 - 7pm. Make the time and invite another person to join with you for quiet contemplation and prayerful intercession for the needs of all in our community and in the world at large.

On Fridays for the Summer grandparents are invited to bring their grandchildren, living close by or staying for sleep over or holidays, to the morning 9.30am Mass in our parish. Fr. Mark and Fr. Anthony will focus upon this sacred bond between the generations.
