The firstfruits of hope (Rom 8:19-25)

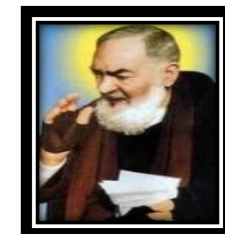
THE SEASON OF CREATION has a special significance for the Catholic Church, particularly since Pope Francis established 1 September as an annual World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. The Season of Creation is marked throughout the Christian world from 1 September to 4 October (Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi) and celebrates the joy of creation as well as encouraging awareness-raising initiatives to protect the natural environment. "Future generations will never forgive us if we miss the opportunity to protect our common home. We have inherited a garden; we must not leave a dessert for our children." Joint statement from Pope Francis, Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew and Archbishop Justin Welby of Canterbury.

THE CHRISTIANS IN BETHLEHEM Bishop Tom welcomes a missionary group from Bethlehem to visit the parishes of our Diocese during this pastoral year. The need to support the remaining Christians left in the Holy Land is great.
