CONFIRMATION 2025 As the countdown begins to the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation in our



parishes we welcome the candidates this weekend as they bring their Passports and reflect upon the life of the Saints, such as the example of St. Brigid. We pray that they may grow in appreciation of the Communion of Saints, as we profess in the creed, which guides and inspires us along the way in this passing world to Heaven. In preparation for receiving the Sacrament a prayer service will be held with each class in school during the coming days, focusing on the symbol of the Chrism Oil and the Parish Register of Confirmation in which their names will be written.
