Feast of the Epiphany as we celebrate Little Christmas, we think of the old Irish tradition of Nollaig ná mBan and show our appreciation for all that our mammies and grannies do for our families and for our Church, especially over the Season of Christmas. We thank them for all the love and care they provide at home and indeed for others too.

It is tradition in many European countries for Epiphany to chalk over the door 20+C+M+B+25 with a cross etched upon this equation, giving witness to the worship the household holds for Jesus, the Son of God throughout the year ahead. If children wish to dress as the Three Kings (The Magi or Wise Men) and come to worship the Infant in the Crib we would be delighted to welcome them to the celebration of the Mass tomorrow Monday 6th January at 9.30am & 7pm in St. Cianán's, Duleek.

THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF EASTER AND THE MOVEABLE FEASTS: ON THE FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY THE HOLY CHURCH ANNOUNCES. Know dear brothers and sisters that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Saviour. On the 5th day of March will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season. On the 20th day of April you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ. On the 1st day of June will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ. On the 8th day of June, the feast of Pentecost. On the 15th day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On the 30th day of November, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen

In this same way, "with haste", we too are called to recover lost hope, to renew that hope in our hearts, and to sow seeds of hope amid the bleakness of our time and our world. And there is so much desolation at this time. We think of wars, of children being shot at, bombs on schools and hospitals.
