THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM "With joy the Christian Community welcomes you."


These are words from the opening gestures of the Rite of Baptism. Baptism involves the whole faith community and together we share the journey of following Christ who leads us to Heaven, by means of the grace of this wonderful sacrament. The effects of Baptism include freedom from original and personal sin, making the baptized a new creature in Christ,


an adopted son or daughter of God, and a member of the Body of Christ (the Church). It also imparts sanctifying grace, the theological virtues (faith, hope, and charity), the gifts of the Holy Spirit, and a permanent, indelible spiritual mark or character that claims them for Christ.

To make arrangements for the Sacrament of Baptism, please contact the Parish Office. The completed Sacrament of Baptism Booking Form is then returned at the weekend Mass, after which the priest will bless the family in preparation for the Baptism. Pre-Baptism Courses take place on the last Thursday of every month and parents are requested to attend one of these meetings before the intended Baptism date.

Let us keep all of those who are to be baptised in our prayers. A Pregnancy Blessing can also be requested at any time from Fr Stephen or Fr Brendan either after the Mass or by contacting the Parish Office.

RCIA PROGRAMME 2025/26 Are you, or someone you know interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church? Discover the beauty and truth of the Catholic Faith through the RCIA process. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, or RCIA, is the process through which those who have never been baptized prepare for initiation into the Catholic Church. The RCIA process helps adults to grow in faith through prayer, study, accompaniment, and worship.
