

OCTOBER AND THE HOLY ROSARY

October is the Month dedicated to the Holy Rosary. This tradition stems from the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, celebrated on October 7, established by Pope St. Pius V in 1571 to commemorate the Christian victory at the Battle of Lepanto. The Church encourages the faithful to pray the Rosary throughout October to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary and to ask for her protection and for peace in the world. In offering the few minutes for the daily rosary we simply, yet powerfully, use the beads to meditate upon the mysteries of the life of Christ and of His Blessed Mother, and we seek Our Lady's intercession in all of our needs. Why

not take up the Rosary as a family prayer during this month? 'We fly to Thy protection, O Holy Mother of God. Do not despise our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers, O Glorious and Blessed Virgin'.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION 2026

Many children of our parish will now begin their preparation to receive the Sacraments of First Confession, First Holy Communion and Confirmation. Parents, the parish and the schools all work together in order to ensure that these are prayerful and joyful occasions for the children. Parents are encouraged to accompany their children to Holy Mass every Sunday, as well as assisting the children in learning their prayers and growing in their faith. Enrolment Forms for the children receiving these Sacraments will be distributed after all Masses this weekend and next weekend, and can also be collected from the parish office.
