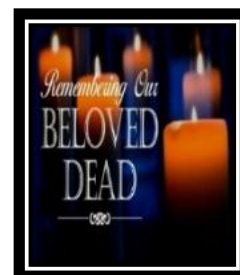

NOVEMBER A TIME TO REMEMBER During November we commemorate the Faithful
Departed. We compile our own individual list of our beloved dead and add them to the *Parish
List of the Dead 2024*. A Parish List of the Dead envelope should have been delivered to your
home. Alternatively, you can pick up a List of the Dead and an envelope in the church porches
or mark any envelope 'Parish List of the Dead'. Please return your List and Offering at any
Mass. Throughout November at every Mass and on the First Friday's of every month we
remember and pray for the repose of the souls of all the Faithful Departed.

**On Thursday 6th November at 7:30pm in St. Cianán's Church a special Mass of Remembrance will be
offered, at which we will think especially of the parishioners whom we have buried since this time last year.**
We invite their families to join us for this Memorial, as we recognise their grief and support them with our
prayers. We also invite other parishioners who may have lost loved ones and celebrated their funerals elsewhere.
Please come and join with us as we pray for the gentle repose of their souls in the eternal love and mercy of God.



TREE OF MEMORY In both our churches we have placed a *Tree of Memory* on which we placed
the names of our parishioners who lived here in the parish and who died in the past twelve
months. Everyone is invited to write the names of their loved ones who died elsewhere this past
year and also place them on the branches. Tags are available at the foot of the Tree. Also, if you
wish simply to remember those who are part of your Family Tree and are now gone before us
into God's eternal merciful embrace, then please write their names and add them to our *Tree of
Memory*.



CATHEDRAL OF CHRIST THE KING To celebrate the Feast of Christ the King on
Sunday 23rd November there will be a 40 Hours Adoration beginning with Mass at 7:30pm
on Friday 21st, concluding with Solemn Vespers and Benediction at 4 pm on Sunday 23rd.
As part of the 40 Hours Devotion, Confessions will be heard continually from 12 noon to
12 midnight on Saturday 22nd November. While each parish of the diocese will be assigned to
a particular hour of adoration, people are in no way restricted to their parish's hour. It
is hoped that people from around the Diocese will come to the Cathedral during this time
to pray. **Our Parish has been assigned to the hour 3-4pm on Sunday 23rd and a bus
has been booked to make it easier for people to travel and participate in the Holy Hour. To book a place
on the bus (donation only) please contact the Parish Office as soon as possible.**

ADORATION & EUCHARISTIC BENEDICTION Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament
with Eucharistic Benediction takes place in St. Cianán's Church, Duleek every Tuesday from
6.00 to 7.00pm, and every Saturday from 5.00pm to 6.00pm. Confessions are also available on
Saturday from 6. 00pm to 6.30pm. In Bellewstown, Adoration and Eucharistic Benediction take
place every Wednesday from 8.30am to 9.30am. Parishioners are very welcome to come along,
in order to enjoy quiet contemplation and prayer before Our Blessed Lord in the Eucharist.
