THE FEAST OF THE DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

Today's Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica, which is celebrated annually on 9th November. In the city of Rome, there are four major basilicas. The first three are Saint Peter's Basilica in Vatican City, the Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls, and the Basilica of Saint Mary Major. The fourth is the Archbasilica Cathedral of the Most Holy Savior and of Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist in the Lateran, also called Saint John Lateran, or the Lateran Basilica for short. Of the four major basilicas, the oldest and most important is Saint John Lateran, the dedication of which is remembered today. Though the pope now lives next to Saint Peter's Basilica, Saint John Lateran is the official cathedral of Rome. That means Saint John Lateran is not only the mother church of the Archdiocese of Rome but also the mother church of the entire world. Today's feast day therefore honours the history of this Cathedral as the mother church and symbolizes the unity of all Catholics throughout the world.



TREE OF MEMORY FOR OUR DECEASED

In both our churches we have placed a *Tree of Memory* on which we placed the names of our parishioners who lived here in the parish and who died in the past twelve months. Everyone is invited to write the names of their loved ones who died elsewhere this past year and also place them on the branches. Also, if you wish simply to remember those who are part of your Family Tree and whom we now entrust to God's merciful embrace, you may write their names and add them to our *Tree of Memory*. Tags are available at the foot of the Tree. Throughout November at every Mass and on the First Fridays of every month we remember and pray for the repose of the souls of all the Faithful Departed.

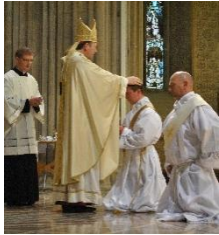


40 HOURS ADORATION IN CATHEDRAL OF CHRIST THE KING

To celebrate the Feast of Christ the King on Sunday 23rd November there will be 40 Hours of Eucharistic Adoration beginning with Mass at 7:30 pm on Friday 21st, and concluding with Solemn Vespers and Benediction at 4 pm on Sunday 23rd. It is hoped that people from around the Diocese will come to the Cathedral during this time to pray. Bishop Tom has asked that prayers would be offered for the following intentions during the weekend: for the children preparing for the Sacraments and for their families, that they may grow in love for Christ in the Eucharist; for a return to the Sunday Mass in our parish communities; for vocations to the priesthood and religious life in our Diocese. We will also carry in our hearts the prayer for peace in the Holy Land - that peace may endure and last. **Duleek Parish has been assigned to the hour of Adoration from 3.00pm to 4.00pm on Sunday 23rd November. This will be followed by Solemn Vespers at 4.00pm, at which Bishop Alan McGuckian SJ, Bishop of Down and Connor, will be the preacher. A bus has been booked by the parish, and it will leave St. Cianan's Church at 1.00pm. To book places on the bus (donation only) please contact the Parish Office as soon as possible.**
