CELEBRATING ADVENT 2025



The 'Bethlehem Candle' is lit today on our Advent wreath. This second candle represents 'faith' and joins our first candle of 'hope' in our Advent reflection and prayer. It is by faith that we unite ourselves to God. We can reflect today on the great gift of our Catholic faith that has been given to us. We can also continue our Advent practices: lighting an Advent candle or wreath at home each day; opening the doors on an Advent Calendar; or pausing to pray the

Angelus, which reminds us of the generous response of Our Lady and our shared role in God's divine plan of salvation. We can also recall the poverty of the crib and the needs of the poorest in our world as we prepare for Christmas.

BRINGING BABY JESUS TO MASS - 'BAMBINELLI' DAY

Next weekend, we invite all children and families to bring the Baby Jesus figure from your home crib, or even your whole crib set, to any of our weekend Masses. After each Mass, we will have a special blessing of the Bambinelli, asking God's grace upon our homes and families as we prepare for Christmas.
