FEAST OF ST BRIGID

Today is the Feast of St. Brigid, Abbess and Secondary Patron of Ireland. The St. Brigid's Cross is a symbol of protection and blessing, traditionally woven from rushes or straw. It holds profound spiritual significance in ancient Christian tradition as it symbolises the cross of Jesus Christ. It is an Irish tradition for such crosses to be placed in farm sheds to protect the animals from any harm and to seek God's blessing upon all involved in farming as springtime begins.

FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD: 2ND FEBRUARY

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord commemorates Mary and Joseph presenting the infant Jesus in the Jerusalem Temple. Also called Candlemas Day, it is a feast of light, marking Jesus as "a light for revelation to the Gentiles." On Monday 2nd February at 9.30am, Holy Mass will be celebrated in St. Cianan's Church for this feast day. Please bring any candles you want blessed to this Mass or you can purchase a blessed candle for €2 at the back of the church after Mass. It is also *The World Day for Consecrated Life* when we pray especially for all of those in religious life and all of those who have taken vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. We pray for all religious institutes and their members: priests, lay brothers, nuns and monks who are consecrated to God. We pray also for all members worldwide of the Institute of the Incarnate Word, the order to which Fr Stephen and Fr Brendan belong.

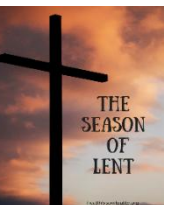


FEAST OF ST BLAISE

The Feast Day of Saint Blaise is celebrated on February 3rd and is marked by the Blessing of the Throats, a tradition where priests use two crossed candles to invoke his protection against throat ailments, stemming from a miracle where he saved a boy choking on a fishbone. St. Blaise, a bishop and martyr, is also the patron saint of wool combers, wild animals, and physicians. All parishioners are invited to Mass on Tuesday morning for the traditional blessing of the throats on this day.

LENT 2026

Lent begins a few weeks from now, with Ash Wednesday taking place on Wednesday 18th February. Lent is a special season in the Church calendar, in which we prepare over 40 days for the Easter Triduum, and Our Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection. Next weekend, we welcome once more the children and families who are preparing to receive the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation.
