POPE LEO'S FIRST ENCYCLICAL:

Pope Leo XIV's first encyclical, 'Magnifica Humanitas', on safeguarding the human person in this time of Artificial Intelligence has just been released. It bears the Pope's signature dated May 15th, which is the 135th Anniversary of the publication of Pope Leo XIII's encyclical 'Rerum Novarum'. The letter speaks about the benefits of AI, particularly in the fields of medicine and education. However, in the lengthy document our Holy Father highlights that prudence is required in the use of AI, in order to avoid dangers to the dignity of the human person and to society at large.
